

A Few More Ideas

- ❖ Glue rocks (make sure they are not small enough to be a choking hazard) to a wood scrap or cardboard.
- ❖ Take cake pans out in the snow and create fancy cakes
- ❖ This could work with wet sand as well
- ❖ String Collage use scraps of yarn or string; soak in a tray or bowl of liquid starch. Let children arrange string and yarn on a piece of cardboard. Let dry over night
