This check list is for your use to track your progress. Your Infant/Toddler Specialist will keep the official copy that will be submitted once all steps have been completed.

<i>1. Create a policy stating your program's commitment to breastfeeding to share with staff and enrolling families.</i>		
<i>2. Train staff in the knowledge and skills needed to promote and support best practice when feeding infants and toddlers.</i>		
<i>3. Inform women and families about the benefits and management of breastfeeding.</i>		
<i>4. Provide learning and play opportunities that normalize breastfeeding for children.</i>		
<i>5. Ensure that all families we serve can properly prepare, label and store breast milk for child care program use.</i>		
<i>6. Provide a breastfeeding friendly environment.</i>		
<i>7. Support breastfeeding employees.</i>		
<i>8. Ensure that each infant has a feeding plan that supports best feeding practices.</i>		
<i>9. Contact and coordinate with local skilled breastfeeding support and actively make referrals.</i>		
<i>10. Continue updates and learning about the protection, promotion and support of breastfeeding.</i>		

Once you have completed each step your Infant/Toddler Specialist will submit to the Infant/Toddler Specialist Network who will review your application and make a recommendation for approval.
